

Music Recommendations
Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A
Sunday, 5 February 2023

The following reading references, psalm responses, antiphons and music recommendations are provided to assist music coordinators in preparing for Confirmation. First Communion Masses should use similar repertoire with particular reference to the Mass of the Day. Priority is given firstly to the major parts of the Mass and the responsorial psalm. A sprinkling rite recalling Baptism is recommended in the introductory rites. The Taize chant "Veni Sancte Spiritus," or similar soft chant, is recommended during the anointing. The Entrance song and the song of praise after communion should be familiar to the parish community, encouraging strong participation by all.
