The following reading references, psalm responses, antiphons and music recommendations are provided to assist music coordinators in preparing for their particular parish community Mass.

Readings

1st Reading

Is 52:13 – 53:12

He surrendered himself to death, while bearing the faults of many.

Responsorial Psalm (PAT1-31)

Ps 30 (31):2. 6. 12-13. 15-17. 25. R. Lk 23:46

Father, I put my life in your hands.

2nd Reading

Heb 4:14-16; 5:7-9

He learned obedience and became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him.

Gospel Acclamation (GA-L12)

Phil 2:8-9

Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!
Christ became obedient for us even to death,
dying on the cross.
Therefore God raised him on high
and gave him a name above all other names.
Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!

Gospel

Jn 18:1 – 19:42

The passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John

The Good Friday Liturgy comprises only:

1. Liturgy of the Word
 2. Adoration of the Cross
 3. Holy Communion
- (There are no Introductory or Concluding rites)

Antiphons

Showing of the Cross

Behold the wood of the Cross,
on which hung the salvation of the world.
- *Come, let us adore. (3 times)*

Adoration Antiphon or other suitable song.

We adore your Cross, O Lord,
we praise and glorify your holy Resurrection,
for behold, because of the wood of a tree
joy has come to the whole world.

Cf. Ps 66 (67): 2

May God have mercy on us and bless us;
may he let his face shed its light upon us
and have mercy on us. *(repeat antiphon)*

Adoration Chants or other suitable songs.

1. The Reproaches
2. Hymn: Faithful Cross the Saints rely on (*Crux Fidelis*)
3. Hymn: At the cross her station keeping (*Stabat Mater*)

Communion Chant or other suitable song.

Ps 21 (22),

Singing in the Good Friday liturgy:

The liturgy begins with all praying silently for a while (no Entrance song). The first songs are the Responsorial Psalm and the Gospel Acclamation. The antiphons and chants specified above are to be sung during the Adoration of the Cross. The Communion Song (above) is to be sung during communion. There is no Song of Praise. The liturgy ends after the Prayer over the People. All depart in silence (no singing). Ignore 'X' for other songs.
